Hi Bill,

All of the town forests in Orange County (I believe there are 32 now) have clear governance structures, with the exception of Fairlee.

Fairlee is the only town in Orange County that allows unrestricted access by ATVs and mud trucks on their forest roads and trails.

Since the Fairlee town forest adjoins the Brushwood forest, and since ATVs and mud trucks are allowed on the Fairlee town forest, there is some unwanted spillover into Brushwood which has resulted in degraded roads and trails on that forest. West Fairlee has spent time and money to try to block trails at road access points, but when the vandals come over the hill from Fairlee, it is difficult to block all internal trails and impossible to fully protect the Brushwood Forest road and trail system from abuse.
